


# How to use the Justice Rain / CCF Library Online


Register for a new account here at [Sign Up](#). Or paste this in your search bar:

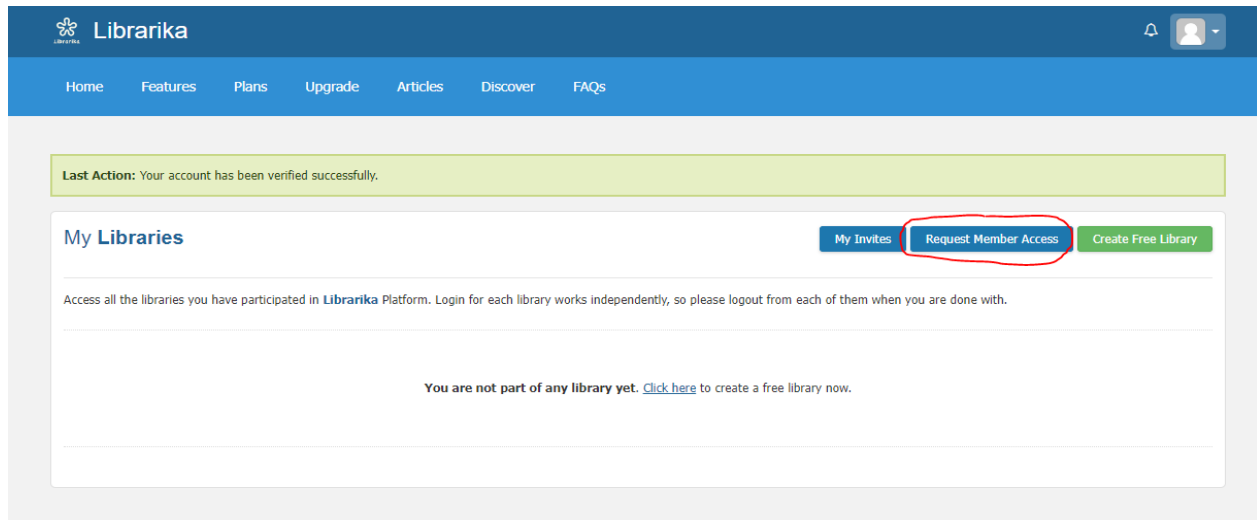

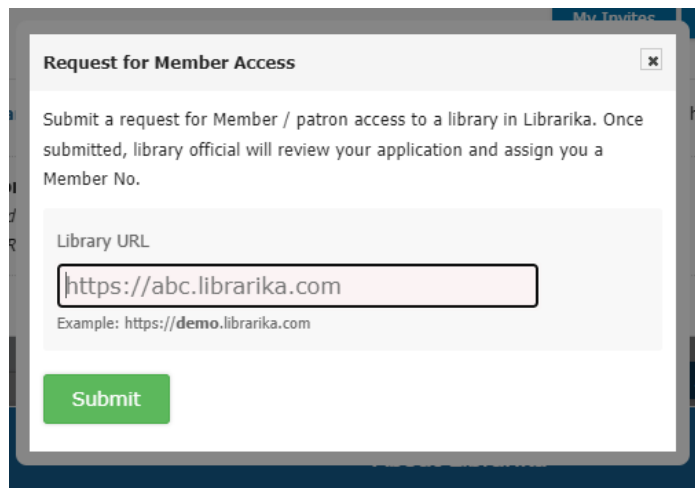
